Temperature-Taking Exercise

The temperature-taking exercise was conducted on Thursday, 28 June 2018. We thank all parents who have supported your child/ward by ensuring that he/she has brought a working thermometer to school for the exercise. This partnership is appreciated and will help to inculcate social responsibility in our students.

The school takes temperature-taking exercise seriously. We have informed parents and students through our end of Term 2 letter dated 24 May 2018 and Term 3 welcome letter dated 25 June 2018 to allow time for all to get ready for the exercise. Teachers would have reminded them in class while we had also reiterated the importance of this exercise to all students during the school assembly on Wednesday, 27 June 2018. Despite these efforts, we are disappointed that there were still some students who either did not have a thermometer with them or their thermometers were not in working conditions.

The temperature-taking exercise is one of the exercises to maintain schools' preparedness to re-activate the temperature-taking regime should there be a need to. It also serves to educate our students to take personal responsibility for their own health and practise social responsibility. It is an annual event for all schools in Singapore and usually conducted twice a year, one on the first week of Term 1 in January and the other on the first week of Term 3 in June. As such, an active participation is expected from all students, supported by their parents. For those students who did not have their thermometers on 28 June 2018, they will be addressed on their responsibility as *Little Masters*.

Moving forward, we seek your co-operation in ensuring your child/ward has a working thermometer for the next temperature-taking exercise.
