In view of the safe management measures where students are required to wear masks in school, students have the option of putting on their P.E. T-shirts on all days to be more comfortable.







Name Tag

Colour: Orange (2022 P1 cohort)












Temporary Plastic Name Tag






Basic Schooling Skills

- Follow school/ class rules
- · Listen attentively for longer periods of time
- · Ask for permission and help
- Pass messages (between school and parents)
- Organise his/her things in the school bag







Basic Life Skills

In preparation for P1, it would be good if your child is able to develop independence by...

- Tying his/her own shoe laces
- Dressing himself/herself
- Eating on his/her own
- Packing his/her own bag
- Having good toilet habits
- · Having good hygiene habits









Student Handbook

- Check your child's handbook for homework/instructions
- The handbook is one of the modes of communication with the teachers.
- Teach your child to show his/her handbook to the teacher if there is any message from the parent.









Online Learning Platforms

- As part of self-directed learning, your child would be tasked to use the computer to complete certain tasks at home.
- Kindly allow your child to log on to the relevant websites/portal to complete the assignments.







Trace Together Token

- In 2022, contact tracing will be fully based on the Trace-Together token.
- Students are required to bring the TT Token to school every day when school reopens in 2022.
- Do check that your child/ward's TT Token is in working order and get a replacement if his/her token is faulty/out of battery.
- If you have yet to collect one for your child/ward, you are strongly encouraged to do so to facilitate contact tracing.





RSS 71st Founder's Day

- The school celebrates her 71st Anniversary on Founder's Day (Thursday, 13 January 2022) from 7.30 am to 10.10 am.
- Students will be dismissed earlier on that day and P1 will be dismissed at 10.10 am.
- Parents/Guardians are to make the necessary transport arrangements for your child/ward after school. School buses will leave the school at approximately 10.40 am when all students have boarded.

Dismissal gate for P1 : Gate 5*

* Students who have elder siblings will be dismissed together with their eldest sibling, at the eldest sibling's dismissal time. Students will wait in their own classrooms to be picked up by their eldest sibling. Students will leave the school via the gate designated for their eldest sibling.

Please wait for your child/ward at the scheduled dismissal time. Parents are reminded to keep a safe distance from one another and not to come too early to fetch your child/ward. After fetching your child/ward, kindly take your leave immediately so that there is more space for our students' movement.

Q: My child takes the school bus. Since it is the first day of school and I have taken leave for the day, can I arrange to fetch him home on the first day by Gate 5?

A: It is <u>not advisable</u> as we would encourage you to set the routine from day 1. Your child may be confused on day 2 and think that dismissal will be from gate 5 and may miss the school bus.









Q: When will I receive the booklist?

The P1 Booklist is already available. When you purchase books from the website of Pacific Bookstore, the booklist will be shown. Otherwise, the booklist is also found on our school website.









Q: Can P1 Parents accompany their child into school on the first day of school?

At this point, only 1 parent would be allowed to accompany the child to school. We will share information on arrangements for the first day of school via Parent Gateway closer to school re-reopening.









Q: Will there be a buddy system?

We hope to be able to implement a buddy system for our P1 students. The school will also ensure that there are enough staff members deployed to guide our P1 students during the first few days at school.

The e-Tour will not be shared after the zoom orientation. P1 Students will have a physical tour around the school in the 1st week of school.




