### **Letter for End of Term 1 2021**

We would like to thank you for your support towards the school's efforts to keep our staff and students safe and healthy.

As we come to the end of the term, we would like to bring to your attention the following updates and reminders:

#### Safety during the March school holidays

a) Online Safety

We urge you to monitor your child/ward's safe use of the internet, and ensure a healthy balance of online and offline activities.

b) Safe Management Measures

When using public transport and outside the home, students are reminded to observe Safe Management Measures and exercise personal responsibility. They are to wear their masks properly, and avoid gathering in groups and having unnecessary conversations in public.

c) Good Personal Hygiene Practices

Students should continue with good hygiene practices such as washing their hands frequently with soap, and also maintain a routine of daily temperature taking.

Please seek prompt medical attention for your child/ward who is not feeling well and allow him/her to rest at home. We would like to seek your cooperation not to send your child/ward to school if he/she is unwell when school reopens. For students staying at home due to illnesses, the school will continue to support them in their learning.

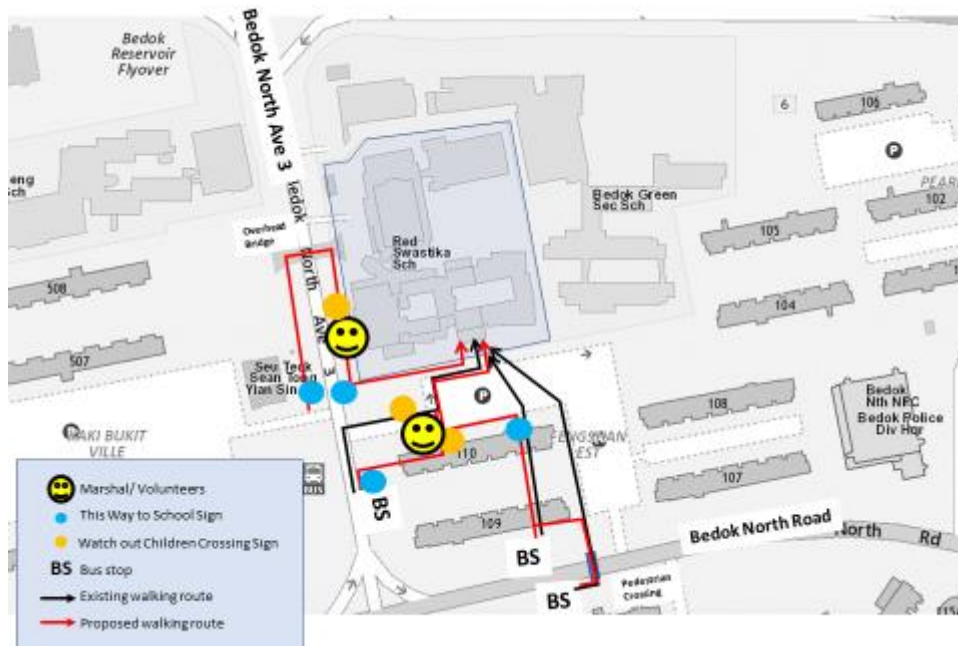
d) Travel

Students should continue to defer overseas travel unless it is permissible under the prevailing MOH travel advisory. Returning travellers from most regions would be placed on Stay Home Notice (SHN). ### b) Joint Advisory with LTA and Traffic Police

A joint safety advisory with LTA and the Traffic Police can be found at Annex A. We seek your cooperation to adhere to the recommended safety measures.

### c) School Dismissal

Parents have been very supportive during dismissal time. We would like to thank you for:

- Waiting at an alternative waiting area and coming towards the school gate dismissal area only at your child's dismissal time;
- Keeping a safe distance of 1 m while waiting for your child/ward;
- Raising your hand when you see your child at the gate. This greatly helps us to facilitate the dismissal process;
- Leaving the waiting area once you have picked up your child so that we can minimize the number of people waiting outside the school;
- Picking your younger child up with his/her elder sibling at the elder sibling's dismissal time. This has helped us to minimize the number of people waiting outside the school;
- Being vigilant and moving your vehicle slowly when driving at the public car parks; and
- Turning off your car engine while waiting.

## Updating of Personal Particulars

If there is any change to the address, contact number/s and commuter status of your child, please inform his/her Form Teacher with the updated details so that we can also update our records for any immediate contact in times of emergency.

## Information on P4 and P6 Semestral Assessment 1 (SA1) 2021

Please refer to Annex B for the P4 and P6 SA1 schedule.

Students who are absent for the main written papers will be given the assessment papers as practice.

The following are considered **valid reason/s for absence/s** during SA1:

- Medical reasons supported by a Medical Certificate (MC) from a doctor or medical practitioner who is registered under the Medical Registration Act on the Singapore Medical Council website.
- Bereavement of family members. A medical certificate or copy of the death certificate has to be given to the Form Teacher when the student returns to school to support his/her absence.

All other reasons are to be considered on a case-by-case basis, subject to the school's approval.

If a student is unwell during the exams, he/she will be taken to the General Office. The school will contact his/her parent/guardian to take him/her home, and the student will not sit for the day's paper(s). Any student who attends school but is supposed to be on medical leave will also not be allowed to take his/her assessment(s).

We urge all parents and students alike to practise social responsibility. When a student who is unwell comes to school, not only will he/she feel uncomfortable, it will also result in other students being exposed to the virus the child has contracted. We therefore urge all parents/guardians to co-operate and assist us in this matter.

We look forward to another term of close collaboration with you when our students return from their school holidays. Here's wishing you and your child/ward a good holiday ahead.

### **Road Safety Advisory**

The Traffic Police (TP), Land Transport Authority (LTA) and Red Swastika School (RSS) have received numerous feedback from residents and the motoring public regarding the traffic situation outside RSS along Bedok North Avenue 3 during the school's arrival hours.

We are concerned about the safety of the students, pedestrians and other road users when motorists conduct late weaving near the access to enter the HDB carpark and school for drop-off activities. In addition, the lane cutting activities often hold up traffic and cause inconvenience to other road users.

For the safety of students and other road users, we urge all parents/guardians who drive, to queue along Bedok North Ave 3 to enter the HDB carpark to drop-off their children. Parents can also consider entering the same carpark from Bedok North Road.

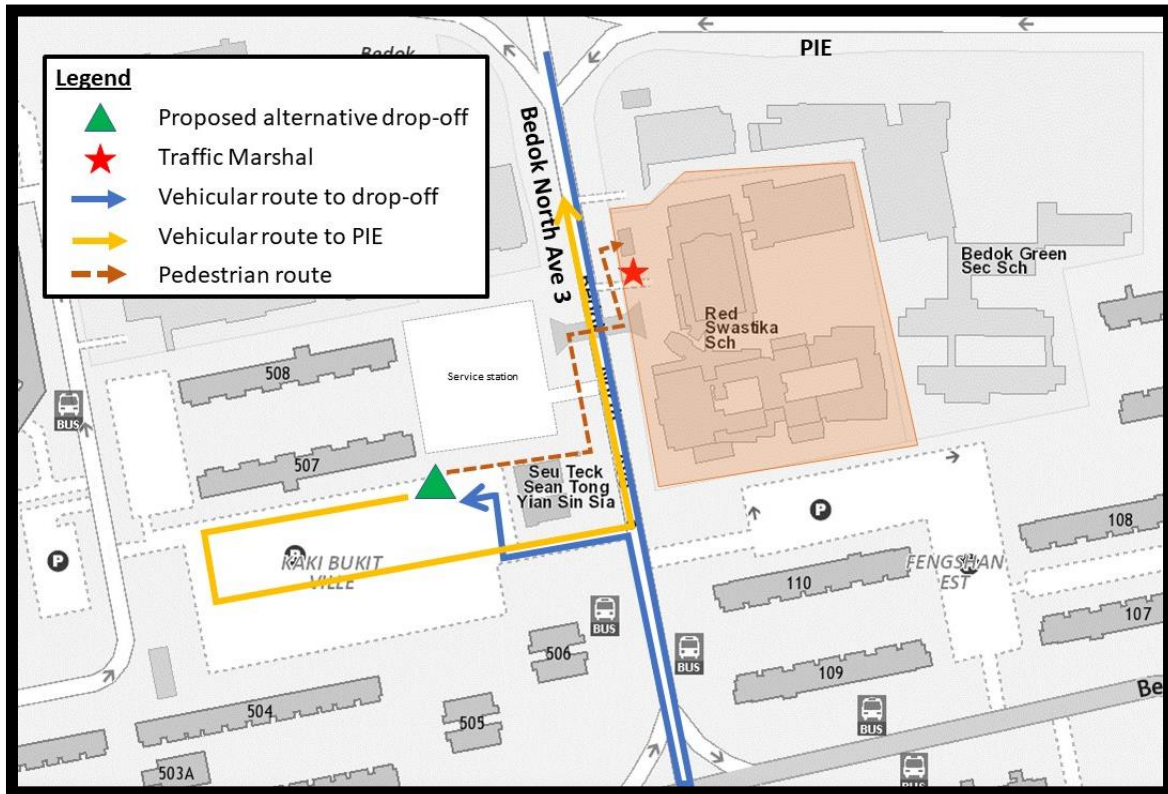
Alternatively, parents may wish to consider dropping off the students at the HDB carpark opposite the school where the students are able to cross the existing pedestrian overhead bridge to access the school as shown in **figure 1** below. The school and LTA are also installing signages along the above-mentioned route to guide students to school safely.

We would also like to remind parents not to encroach into the yellow boxes at the egress of Bedok Green Secondary School, RSS and the HDB carpark to ensure smooth traffic flow.

Road Safety is a shared responsibility. We seek your assistance to play your part, be considerate to other road users and stay safe. LTA and TP will take firm enforcement actions against any motorist who violates traffic regulations.
