6th SAP SCHOLARS PROGRAMME TO CHINA, NANJING

1. Our school will be organizing our 6th SAP Scholars Programme to China, Nanjing, between 28 May to 18 June 2016. We would like to congratulate you as your child has been selected for the programme.
2. This 3-week curriculum is a collaborative effort between Red Swastika School and Nanjing Pu Kou Qu Xingzhi Primary School. This programme is designed to further strengthen the bilingual and bicultural capabilities in our top students. It is an extended immersion experience in China which would allow for greater appreciation of culture and the use of the Chinese language. Two teacher chaperons from Red Swastika School will be assigned for the 3-week programme. The students will be staying in Nanjing Pu Kou Qu Xingzhi Primary School Hostel.
3. Like previous years, students of this 6th SAP Scholars Programme are selected based on 2015 Overall Conduct Grades, teacher's recommendations and their outstanding English and Chinese academic results in 2016 Mock Test. A total of 21 students have been shortlisted for the programme.
